Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon, Marselan, Syrah, Egiodola

Yield: 15-18 hl/ha

Vinification: Maceration and fermentation in stainless steel tanks

Aging: French oak 12-15 months

Aroma: Intense, balanced aromas of black fruits (black currant, blackberry), red fruits (cranberry), black currant leaf, with notes of sweet spices (cinnamon, cloves) and delicate vanilla in the final

Taste: Mild, harmonic body, with very good length and volume. Excellent fruitiness with red and black fruits characteristics (blackberry, blueberry, cherry). Long aftertaste with notes of caramel, vanilla, smoke and tobacco

Serving temperature: 18-20°C

Food pairings: Roasted meat, porcini, duck and hard cheese
