The rapidly growing popularity of Zweigelt in Austria is mainly due to its versatility. The grapes for our Blauer Zweigelt Rubin thrive in the best locations around our wine village Ottenthal. Every year we create the best possible conditions for this excellent wine through intensive foliage work and yield regulation in the vineyards.

15 month matured in French oak

TASTING NOTES

You can smell the typical sour cherry fruit with delicate blackberry notes. The aging in French oak gives it soft toasted aromas which harmonize very well with the soft Zweigelt tannins.



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
