Grower

Németh János is a passionate, new-generation winemaker based in Szekszárd, dedicated to crafting elegant, terroir-driven wines that combine tradition with modern precision. His focus is on producing expressive, characterful wines in small quantities with minimal intervention.

Region

The Szekszárd wine district, located in southern Hungary's Tolna County, lies between the Tolna-Baranya Hills and the Dunamenti Plain. Vineyards stretch along the eastern slopes from Szekszárd to Bába, on loess-rich soils ideal for black grapes. The region covers 6,001 hectares, with 2,116 hectares under vine. Its warm continental climate and minimal frost risk favor varieties like Kadarka and Kekfrankos

Vineyards

The grapes for this Cabernet Franc come from 'Görögszó' vineyard loess-rich plot, which contribute to the wine's round texture and aromatic depth. Careful vineyard management and low yields (2 kg per vine) ensure concentrated fruit quality and varietal purity.

Vinification

Fermented spontaneously with native yeasts in open-top fermenters, enhancing complexity and texture. The wine was aged for 14 months in 500-liter oak barrels (2nd and 3rd fill), allowing subtle oak integration while preserving freshness and varietal character.

Tasting Notes

This is a varietally pure and elegant Cabernet Franc, showing fresh acidity and refined structure. Aromas of red and black berries, subtle herbs, and delicate spice are followed by a supple texture and food-friendly balance. A classic bistro-style wine with finesse and drinkability.
