Petz

The grapes for the "Petz" come from vineyards around the villages of Hambach, Maikammer and Edenkoben. The cuvée contains Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and some St. Laurent from a 20-year-old, low-yielding plant that produces extremely fine grapes.

After a traditional, open fermentation followed by maceration for several weeks, the mash was gently pressed and the young wine aged in used French oak barrels.

In those barrels, the different varieties were matured separately for 10 months. The cuvée, assembled from the individual base wines, was bottled without fining and filtration.

The "Petz" is full-bodied and fruity, but still has a very fine nature and is multi-layered.
